

Dripline Clamps

With the rapid popularity of drip irrigation systems, vast areas are covered with driplines for irrigation. **Managing** the dripline is a hassle especially at the point where the dripline emerges from the ground and bends to align with the raised cultivation bed. There is a natural tendency of the dripline to straighten itself; this unbending loosens the dripline from the bed and the dripline moves away from the bed. The water and the critically important fertilisers are wasted. More importantly, the crop dies due to lack of irrigation and fertigation. Our specially prepared dripline clamps are made of very durable material. They last for many, many years. They hold the dripline firmly in the soil.
